MATERIALS:

- 2 mm crochet hook.
- Tapestry Needle.
- Pins
- Scissors.
- 2 black 5mm safety eyes or black embroidery floss.
- Stuffing.
- Stitch markers.
- Cotton yarn.

I've used: Natura Just Cotton de DMC

Body and Outer Ear: n° 39 Ombre **Inner Ear and Nose:** n° 82 Lobelia **Dress:** n° 87 Glacier

Dress: n° 87 Glacie **Lace:** n° 02 Ivory

RECOMMENDATIONS:

You can use any yarn that you like, however, make sure to use a slightly smaller hook (1mm less) than the one recommended on the label to avoid any holes.

The doll is 16 cm but the final size of your doll can vary, depending on the yarn and hook size used, which would mean that you would have to adapt the eyes to a different size.

Work in a continuous spiral unless otherwise stated.

Change yarn colour always in the last step of the last stitch.

You must stuff as you go crocheting.

STITCH LEGEND:

start

sl st - slip stitch

o ch - chain stitch

+ sc - single crochet

T hdc - half doublé crochet

v inc - increase

→ decrease

t dc-inc - 2 dc into same

stitch

blo - back loop only

flo - front loop only

(...) - Repeat the stitches between brackets by (x) the amount of times indicated.

[...] - Make the stitches in brackets in the same stitch.

LEGS

First Leg

1	6 sc in a magic ring	(6)
2	6 inc	(12)
3-20	12 sc	(12)

Second Leg

Repeat the steps of the first leg, but this time don't cut the yarn, make 3 ch and join the first leg.

BODY

21	12 sc, 3 sc in the ch3, 12 sc,	
	3 sc in the ch3	(30)
22-29	30 sc	(30)
30	4 sc, dec, (8 sc, dec)x2, 4 sc	(27)
31	27 sc	(27)
32	(7 sc, dec)x3	(24)
33	24 sc	(24)
34	3 sc, dec (6 sc, dec)x2, 3 sc	(21)
35	21 sc	(21)
36	(5 sc, dec)x3	(18)
37	(1 sc, dec)x6	(12)

Don't break the yarn.

Stuff the body firmly and continue crocheting the head.

HEAD

38	12 inc	(24)
39	(1 sc, inc)x12	(36)
40	(5 sc, inc)x6	(42)
41	3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc)x5, 3 sc	(48)
42-50	48 sc	(48)

Place the safety eyes between rounds 45 and 46, with a distance of 9 stitches between them.

51	3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec)x5, 3 sc	(42)
52	(5 sc, dec)x6	(36)
53	2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)x5, 2 sc	(30)

Stuff the head firmly.

Fasten off and weave through the front loops of the 6 remaining stitches and pull tightly to close the hole.

ARMS

Make two. Don't stuff the arms.

1	5 sc in a magic ring	(5)
2	5 inc	(10)
3-15	10 sc	(10)

Fold and join with 5 sc.

Leave a long yarn tail to sew to the body. Sew the arms between rounds 34 and 35.

EARS

INNER EAR: Make 2

Make ch 10, insert the hook into the second ch from the hook.

1	8 sc, inc, continue crocheting on the	
	other side of the chain, 9 sc.	(18)
2	ch 1, turn, 3 sc, 3 hdc, 3 dc, 4 dc into	the same
	stitch, 3 dc, 3 hdc, 3 sc	(22)

ch 1, turn, 3 sc, 3 hdc, 2 dc, 6 dc-inc, 2 dc, 3 hdc, 3 sc (28)


Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

OUTER EAR: Make 2

Repeat the steps of the inner ear, but this time don't cut the yarn.

4 Join the inner and outer ear with 28 sc.

Follow the steps of the photos on page 4 to join the two parts together.

JOINING THE EARS TOGETHER



1- Crochet the two parts together, one of each color, the rights sides facing outwards. The inner ear should be facing you.



2- Pass the loop of the last stitch from the outer ear to the inner ear.



3- Make ch1. This ch counts as the first stitch of the round.



4- Continue making sc around the ear, you need to use the stitches of both ear pieces to join together. Fasten off and leave a long yarn tail to sew.



5- Fold the ear and sew the two sides together.



6- Pin the ears in the correct place on the head and sew them on.

DRESS

Leave a long strand at the beginning of the first ch, you will need later to sew the dress together.

Make ch 28, insert the hook into the second ch from the hook.

1	27 sc,	(27)
2	ch 1, turn. (1 sc, inc)x13, 1 sc	(40)
3	ch 1, turn, 6 sc, ch 4, skip 8 stitche	?S,
	12 sc, ch 4, skip 8 stitches, 6 sc	(32)
4	ch 3, turn, 2 dc, dc-inc,	
	(3 dc, dc-inc)x7	(40)

From now on, close each round joining the last dc to the 3rd ch of the beginning of the round with sl st.

5-9	ch 3, 39 dc, sl st	(40)	
	Change to the color of the ruffle		
10	(1 sc, ch 2)x40	(120)	
Break the yarn and finish of your work with a			

needle join and hide the yarn tail.

Put the dress on and sew it together at the back.





To finish, embroider the nose and put a little blush on her cheeks.
